



Pre-Travel Event Medical Screening

Summer Camp 2020

To help protect the health of all those choosing to come to a Rocky Mountain Council camp, all those attending will be expected to complete this pre-travel event medical screening. It is to be completed immediately before traveling to camp. We recommend this be done right when an individual arrives at your gathering place before they begin interacting with the others who will be traveling to camp together.

If a participant, youth or adult, is disqualified from coming to camp, they must immediately return to their home so as to not infect others.

Please review this document with all those who are planning to attend a Rocky Mountain Council camp so that they may prepare as needed.

Are you in a higher-risk category as defined by CDC guidelines?		

Higher-risk category includes the following:

- People 65 years of age and older
- People who live in a nursing home or long-term care facility
- People of all ages with underlying medical conditions:
 - Chronic lung disease or moderate to severe asthma
 - Serious heart conditions
 - Those who are immunocompromised
 - Many conditions can cause a person to be immunocompromised, including cancer treatment, smoking, bone marrow or organ transplantation, immune deficiencies, poorly controlled HIV or AIDS, and prolonged use of corticosteroids and other immune weakening medications
 - Severe obesity (body mass index [BMI] of 40 or higher)
 - Diabetes
 - Chronic kidney disease undergoing dialysis
 - Liver disease

If the answer is “Yes” to this question, we recommend that the participant consult with their primary care provider and/or their specialist for their specific condition prior to deciding on whether or not they will attend camp this summer.
